The London InterCommunity Health Centre is dedicated to creating and maintaining an environment that is accessible and safe for members of the transgender community. We are committed to training our staff in the areas of Gender Expression, Gender Identity and Sexual Orientation to ensure that everyone coming through our doors feels heard and respected by our team. Policies of inclusion ensure that programs are aligned with our goal of trans accessibility.

In early 2015, the Health Centre introduced a new role: Health Worker, Transgender Communities. The Health Worker is a frontline staff member committed to supporting positive change in the lives of transgender individuals at any stage of their journey. The Health Worker establishes and maintains trusting relationships within the community and acts as a liaison between clients and health and social services providers with a goal of facilitating access to services, and improving the quality and cultural competency of service delivery.

The Health Worker for Transgender Communities connects trans people with Health Centre and community resources. An initial offering is **Gender Journeys**, an eight week group providing participants with the opportunity to explore the social, emotional and physical aspects of gender change, while covering a broad range of topics.
