The London InterCommunity Health Centre offers health and social services to people experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Our interdisciplinary care team operates within a health promotion framework. Nursing, social work and the services of community workers from our Poverty, Homelessness and Options Team are available to both registered and non-registered clients. Primary health services provided by our nurse practitioner and our physician are available to medical clients only.

Other services include:

- Shower and laundry facilities
- ID replacement clinics (for lost or stole identification)
- Mail service
- Social assistance applications and advocacy
- Housing loss prevention support and advocacy
- The Naxolone Program

Health Outreach Activity Council (HOAC)

The HOAC plans and supports peer-driven and peer-focused social activities. They are dedicated to creating ways for people experiencing homelessness or at risk, to make connections within their own communities in meaningful ways.

Community Programs

We offer daily scheduled activities and programs facilitated by staff and members of the HOAC designed to promote wellness, harm reduction best practices, growth of emotional intelligence and community inclusion.
