Our physicians are supported by a corporate service department, on a salaried model (no OHIP billings or billing expenses), ensuring time available for patient appointments that address complex, interesting medical and social issues, without administrative overhead to be concerned about.

Physicians are dedicated to one clinic on a regular basis and provide coverage to other physicians in the Health Centre during periods of absence. All staff at the health centre work to full scope and knowledge transfer and skill enhancement among practitioners is high.
